***The stadium lights hum, casting long
shadows across the grass as the final
whistle echoes. For most, the game
is over, but for some of the players
gathered in the center circle,
their real purpose just continues.***

Moments before, Alisson Becker stood tall in the goal, but his mind isn't on the clean sheet he's just kept. He often tells teammates that while he loves the game, his 'complete trust in the Son of God' is the only thing that gives his life true meaning. To him, every save is a chance to point upward, reminding the fans that *"Jesus is the Way."*

Nearby, Bukayo Saka walks off the pitch with a quiet peace. People often ask how he handles the crushing pressure of a nation's expectations. His answer is always the same: he reads his Bible every night. He plays with the freedom of someone who knows his worth isn't tied to a scoreboard, but to a Creator who loves him regardless of the result.

Like Olivier Giroud, who carries a Psalm tattooed on his arm as a permanent prayer, these men view the pitch as their platform. They speak of a "Final Whistle" that eventually comes for every person—a moment when trophies turn to dust. Their message to the world is simple: don't wait for "extra time" to be right with God. Just as a team

needs a captain, every sinner needs a Saviour to lead them home.
